Invites proposals to collaborate for organizing conferences, seminars and workshops on issues relating to Human Rights during 2026-27

The National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) has been constituted in accordance with the provisions of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993. Section 12 of the Act lays down the functions to be performed by the Commission. As per Section 12 (h) of the Act, the Commission is mandated to 'spread human rights literacy among various sections of society and promote awareness of the safeguards available for the protection of these rights through publications, the media, seminars and other available means'. In pursuance of this mandate, the Commission invites proposals from reputed institutions, universities, national law schools, civil society organizations, autonomous bodies, etc. for organizing international & national conferences, seminars and workshops to further the cause of protection and promotion of human rights.

The topic of the conference/ seminar/ workshop should be relevant to human rights as mentioned under clause 3 of the attached guidelines and submitted in the prescribed format along with the relevant documents as mentioned in the guidelines.

1. Thrust Areas/ Themes of the conferences, seminars and workshops:

The institutions as mentioned in clause 3 of the attached guidelines, may submit their proposals on the thematic subjects as mentioned in **Annexure IV** of the attached guidelines.

2. Eligibility criteria (refer to clause 3 of the attached guidelines):

- i.) Universities, Institutions, Law Schools; (covered under section 2 (f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act 1956);
- ii.) Autonomous bodies and research organisations;
- iii.) Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) at the state or national level, with a minimum of three years of experience; proven research capability in Human rights issues and concerns (NGOs must not have received cancellation under section 14 of FCRA 2010, and must be registered on NGO-DARPAN portal);
